Suicide Thoughts? Help is Available EAP

The holiday season can be a stressful time for anyone and the Employee Assistance Program has prepared some information for employees that need to communicate their concerns.

The EAP National Joint Committee (NJC) is sponsoring a suicide prevention campaign for your workplace and material is being made available to anyone that requests the information. Often times talking about suicide prevention can be a sensitive and difficult thing to do by family or friends, but learning more about suicide and being prepared to get involved can help save a life.

EAP is offering new tools to help you and family members and friends be prepared. EAP also provides a short video, "Removing the Stigma" encouraging all employees to break the stigma of mental health and to encourage reaching out to the EAP.

A presentation on suicide prevention, "Suicide Prevention in the Workplace" provides education and awareness for members about suicide prevention for families, friends, and co-workers.

Posters are available that focus on alcohol abuse awareness, anxiety awareness, and domestic violence awareness. EAP has found that Handouts Break the Stigma of Mental Health and provide a better understanding on the importance of breaking the stigma to reaching out for mental health help. Providing this information to our family members and friends is one way of showing support.
